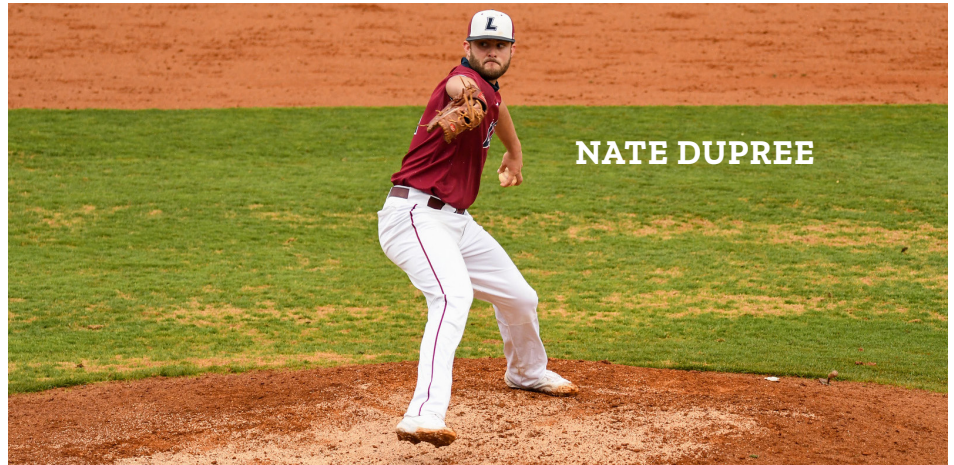

GAME NOTES

- The Lee baseball has continued to climb in the national polls. The Flames are currently No. 2 in the April 18 NCBWA Poll and are No. 6 in the April 19 Collegiate Baseball Poll.
- Lee head coach Mark Brew went over 600 wins at West Alabama. He enters this weekend at 603-233-2, all at Lee.
- The Flames have won five straight since their 13-game win streak was ended with losses in the first two games of the Shorter series.
- Mississippi College enters with a seven-game streak. The Choctaws won the final game of the West Georgia series 11-0 in seven innings and followed that with three-game sweeps of Christian Brothers and AUM.
- The Flames are No. 4 in the GSC with a team batting average of .297. MC is No. 7 (.280).
- Lee and MC are in the top four in the conference in home runs. The Flames are No. 1 with 51, while the Choctaws are No. 4 with 37.
- Ryan Beamish is tied with Tucker Greer (Young Harris) with 17 home runs to lead all of DII.
- After this weekend's games, the Flames travel to

- Pensacola, Fla., for the final GSC series of the regular season against West Florida.
- There has been a format change announced to this year's GSC Baseball Championship.
- The Championship will use a split double-elimination bracket with the No. 1, 4, 5 and 8 seeds in one bracket and the No. 2, 3, 6 and 7 seeds in the other. This first round will be held at Choccolocco Park in Oxford, Ala. from May 7-11.
- The winners of each bracket will face off in a best-of-3 series hosted by the higher seed on May 18-20.
- Lee and West Florida are the only teams to have clinched a berth into the GSC Championship.
- The Flames and Argonauts are tied with 23 conference wins, but the Argonauts have lost four more than Lee.
- The Flames can clinch the GSC Regular Season Championship and the No. 1 seed with at least two wins in combination with one UWF loss. A Lee sweep of Mississippi College would secure the No. 1 seed for the Flames as well. Two Lee wins without a West Florida loss leaves the door open for the Argonauts in the head-to-head battle next week.
