### **GAME NOTES**

- The Flames received 12 points and are the first team outside the NABC Coaches Poll. In the D2SIDA poll, Lee moved up one spot to No. 24.
- Quay Kennedy has tallied 841 points in 72 games in his Lee career (11.7 ppg).
- Michael McGuirk is the only other Flame over 500 career points with 610. Jason Landman enters the weekend with 436 points in his career.
- Three of the four berths for the East Division have been clinched. Valdosta State, Lee and West Georgia are in, while Montevallo and West Florida are in a battle for the fourth seed.
- The top three seeds are still undecided. West

Georgia has completed its GSC schedule and are 12-6 (.667). Valdosta State is currently at the top with a 12-4 (.750) record with Lee right behind at 11-4 (.733). The Flames will secure one of the top two seeds and a home game with one win this weekend. In order to earn the No. 1 seed, the Flames will need to win one more game than VSU, who travel to West Florida.

- In the West Division, UAH has secured the No. 1 seed, while Union, West Alabama and Delta State have clinched playoff spots.
- First Round: No. 4 West at No. 1 East; No. 3 East at No. 2 West; No. 3 West at No. 2 East; and No. 4 East at No. 1 West.
