GAME NOTES

- The Flames are set to play their first home game tonight against Shorter. This game was originally scheduled for Dec. 16. Lee also had a single home date with Valdosta State (Dec. 19) postponed and a weekend series (Jan. 2-3) against Montevallo postponed.
- Lee has posted four consecutive wins following a season-opening loss at West Florida. The Flames swept a weekend series at West Georgia before claiming 82-70 and 77-74 wins at No. 5 Valdosta State season opener 75-70 against West Georgia. The this past weekend.
- Quay Kennedy was selected GSC East Division Player of the Week for the second consecutive week.

- Kennedy averaged 24 points and seven rebounds in the two wins at Valdosta State.
- Beyuan Hendricks averaged 12.5 points, 6.0 assists and 4.0 rebounds for the weekend.
- Makhi McGuire earned GSC East Division Freshman of the Week for the second time this season after averaging 8.5 points, 3.5 rebounds, 1.0 steal and 0.5 assists this past weekend.
- Shorter has lost three straight after winning its Hawks then lost 85-81 to West Georgia before being swept (99-85 and 86-70) at Valdosta State on Jan. 8-9.
