Series Record: Lee leads 8-7 and have won four straight.

Last Meeting: Jan. 9, 2021, in Carrollton, Ga. Quay Kennedy sunk a free throw with 1.3 seconds remaining to give Lee a 60-59 win and the weekend sweep. Kennedy finished with 14 points and six rebounds. Noah Boler added 14 points and five boards. Michael Zabetakis led West Georgia with 17 points and eight rebounds.

GAME NOTES

- Lee had its eight-game win streak snapped last Friday at Shorter. The Flames hadn't lost since their opening game at West Florida on Dec. 12.
- The Flames dropped to No. 19 in this week's NABC Coaches Poll. In the D2SIDA poll, Lee fell two spots to No. 15.
- Following this weekend's games, the Flames travel to Montevallo for their final road series of the regular season.
- The Flames are scheduled to complete the regular season at home on Feb. 26-27 against AUM.
- Lee is averaging 72.5 points per game and are allowing 64.8 ppg for a +7.7 scoring margin.

- The Flames also hold a +4.1 rebounding advantage, recording 35.8 rpg to their opponents' 31.7 rpg.
- Quay Kennedy is fourth in the GSC, averaging 17.3 points per game. He is 10th in rebounding at 6.0 rpg.
- UWG's Oronte' Anderson is second in the GSC with 5.2 assists per game. Beyuan Hendricks' 3.7 apg average is eighth-best.
- Kennedy has tallied 769 points in 68 games in his Lee career (11.3 ppg).
- Michael McGuirk is the only other Flame over 500 career points with 567. Jason Landman enters the weekend with 424 points in his career.
