GAME NOTES

Tonight the Lee University Athletic Department is privileged to honor the coaching legacy of Andrea Hudson.

Coach Hudson has led the Lee volleyball program with excellence for 30 seasons. She has posted 842 wins, went to three straight NAIA Final Fours in 2009, 2010 and 2011. On this very court she amassed a remarkable 78 match winning streak and in 2015 she won the prestigious NCAA D2 Award of Excellence for her work with Volley For A Cure. In 13 years the Volley For A Cure event has raised over \$300,000 for Breast Cancer Awareness and Research.

With her husband Kevin always beside her on the bench, the twosome took the volleyball teams from NCCAA play and began to carve a lasting mark against NAIA competition, dominating play in three conferences, TVAC, TranSouth and SSAC. As a couple they continued to work together as Lee transitioned to NCAA DII leading the 2017 team to the program's first GSC Tournament victory over West Alabama. In 2018 the Lady Flames posted a 13-3 mark as Silvia Sartori

was named an All-American and the GSC Player of the Year while Makayla Beebe earned GSC Libero of the Year honors.

Lee Athletic Director, Larry Carpenter had this to say about Andrea, "When you think of Lee volleyball, the first person that comes to mind is Coach Hudson. She has led the program with excellence for 30 years and it will be a big adjustment not seeing her on the bench."

Coach Hudson, thank you for leaving an indelible mark on the Lee Volleyball program. Thank you for coaching with excellence and leading our teams to have an unprecedented amount of success on the court with over 840 wins. But more importantly, thank you for the lasting impact you have had on so many young women that goes far beyond wins and losses. You have developed and graduated champions in the classroom, on the volleyball court, in their faith and in the community.
