GAME NOTES

- Haley Schubert continues her ascent to 1,000 career points. She currently sits at 987 points in 75 games. She is averaging 13.2 ppg for her career.
- After losing four of five games, including a pair to Montevallo in make-up games on Jan. 30 and 31, the Lady Flames have posted four straight victories, while the Falcons have put five of six wins on the board with the only loss in that stretch coming against Valdosta State.
- Montevallo set a school record with 15 3-pointers in their win against Lee on Jan. 31.
- There will be an adjustment to the bracket format for the 2021 GSC Men's and Women's Basketball

Championships. Dates of competition will be on Tuesday, March 2 (Quarterfinals), Friday, March 5 (Semifinals), and Sunday, March 7 (Championship Games). The first two rounds will be conducted at campus locations, with the higher seed hosting. The finals will be hosted at different neutral sites for the men and women. Those sites will be announced at a later date.

The top four teams in each division will advance to the postseason based on winning percentage. A traditional cross-division bracket will be used (#1 East vs. #4 West, #2 West vs. #3 East, #2 East vs. #3 West, #1 West vs. #4 East).
