

GAME NOTES

- \bullet Freshman Kiersten Havens started her collegiate career off with a bang as she scored in the 82^{nd} minute to give the Lee women's soccer team a 2-1 victory over Lipscomb on Saturday.
- Riley Henry, who transferred from Lipscomb in 2019, set up the game-winning score as she found Havens in stride to help knock off her old team.
- First-year goalkeeper, Jackie Burns recorded seven saves to earn her first victory as a Lady Flame. Burns and a final bracket.
 The GSC men's so groups of five, and to placed 10 on goal to go along with 10 corner kicks.
- Lipscomb tallied the equalizer at 74:37 on a goal by Evee Reader. Emily Patti assisted on the score.
- Kelsey Yoder found the back of the net in the 42nd minute to give the Lady Flames the 1-0 advantage. Mallory Hayden set up the goal on a free kick from near midfield and was credited with the assist. Lee would carry the lead into the intermission thanks to Burns six first half saves and a clean sheet.
- The Bisons, a D1 top 40 program, were the preseason pick to win the Atlantic Sun Conference.

- The Lady Flames open the home portion of the schedule tonight as they welcome Lincoln Memorial to the Lee Soccer Field.
- Lee travels to Valdosta State on Feb. 16 before returning home for three straight home dates: Carson-Newman (Feb. 18), AUM (Feb. 21) and West Georgia (Feb. 27).
- Men's and women's soccer will include pool play and a final bracket.
- The GSC men's soccer teams will be split into two groups of five, and the women's teams will be split into two groups of six. The pools were developed to facilitate efficient competition opportunities for GSC student-athletes and institutions.
- Following NCAA policy, the GSC will collect statistics and results from these spring seasons.
- Wins and losses will count towards all-time standings and coach records, while teams and student-athletes are eligible for single game records and numbers will count towards career records.
- Spring Championship Series Championships will not count as official GSC Championships.
