LEE'S LAST TIME OUT: Lee had won seven of its last eight and two straight before dropping a 9-8 contest to No. 8 Trevecca Nazarene on Tuesday.

ABOUT THE BUCS: Christian Brothers has lost its last six contests. After winning the first two games at then No. 12 Valdosta State (5-4 and 13-12 in 10 innings), CBU lost 2-0 in the series finale, lost 14-3 in seven innings against UAH, were swept by Shorter (19-8, 3-1 and 12-8) and lost 11-6 at Rhodes College this past Tuesday.

DO YOU KNOW JACK?: Jack Nedrow recorded his third consecutive complete-game shutout on Saturday against Tampa. As a result, he earned GSC Freshman of the Week honors for the fourth time this season. The three shutouts are one shy

of the Lee record held by Scott Swinson in the 2010 season. The six complete games is four short of Jay Eller in 2001.

OTHER GSC MATCHUPS: While Lee hosts CBU, Montevallo is at Mississippi College, West Georgia travels to UAH, AUM is at Valdosta State, Union hosts West Alabama and West Florida and Delta State tangle in Mississippi.

POSTSEASON GROWING NEARER: With three weekends remaining on the schedule, eyes are beginning to turn to the postseason.

• The top eight teams will qualify for the doubleelimination tournament which will be played at Choccolocco Park in Oxford, Alabama, and will run from May 5-10.

LOOKING AHEAD: Lee hosts Emmanuel College on Tuesday (April 19) for the last game of the current eight-game home stand. The Flames travel to Montevallo for a three-game series next weekend for their final home conference games.
