

GAME NOTES

- The Lee baseball team enters today's mid-week clash against the Lincoln Memorial Railsplitters at 7-4 after opening Gulf South Conference play taking 2 of 3 at Union last weekend.
- · Freshman pitcher Jack Nedrow was named the GSC Freshman of the Week. The righty from Siegel High School tossed a complete game (7 innings) allowing one run on four hits while striking out five in Lee's 5-1 game two win over the Bulldogs on Saturday.
- The bats got going in a 17-12 win in game three over Union that resembled a rec league softball score. The Flames blasted four home runs total as Dylan Standifer, Jared Demkowicz, Joshua Perez, and Isaac Quinones all left the yard. Standifer finished 4 for 6 with five RBI and two runs scored.
- "Our offense showed up in a big way today and we ended up needing it. (Cameron) Land threw well and (Brycen) Jewell had some huge outs at

the end. It was a crazy game, and we aren't going to be disappointed with winning a GSC series on the road regardless of how we finished," remarked head coach Mark Brew after Sunday's game.

- The Railsplitters come in playing well and are off to a 5-1 start on the year. LMU took 2 of 3 from Cedarville at home last weekend. Ryan Kurth leads the club in average (.371), OPS (1.172), doubles (4) homers (3) and RBI (11).
- The Flames are No. 21 in the latest NCBWA National Poll and No. 7 in the NCBWA South Region Poll.
- Lee will welcome the Valdosta State Blazers to the Carp this weekend. The series is originally scheduled for a single game on Friday at 3 p.m. and a doubleheader on Saturday starting at 1 p.m. However, rain in the forecast could move Friday's single game to Sunday afternoon.
