

GAME NOTES

LEE'S LAST TIME OUT: Lee posted its 30th win of the season with an 8-5 win over Alabama Huntsville in a battle of the final two unbeaten teams. Thomas Zazzaro recorded three of Lee's eight hits. He doubled and drove in three runs. Jared Demkowicz supplied a solo home run in the win. Alan Zhang Carter picked up the win in two innings of relief after giving up one hit and striking out five. Sam Fulton recorded his sixth save of the year.

STREAKING FLAMES: The Flames have won a season-high seven consecutive games.

• Starting with Lee's series finale win over UAH on March 26, the Flames recorded a 15-4 record to finish the regular season and have now won 18 of their last 22. Lee was 12-17 prior to that.

BRACKETOLOGY: Four teams remain with Lee the lone undefeated team at 3-0. Shorter, Delta State and UAH are all 2-1. If Shorter defeats Lee, the Hawks will advance to the 12 p.m. EDT game to face the UAH/DSU winner. Lee would receive a bye to the winner-take-all championship game at 3 p.m. Tuesday.

• A win by Lee will eliminate Shorter and set up a

championship final against either UAH or DSU where the Flames would need to be beaten twice.

LEE SEASON VS GSC CHAMPIONSHIP TEAMS:

FLAMES IN GSC CHAMPIONSHIP: Lee is now 7-5 in their four appearance in the GSC Championship. The Flames reached the GSC Championship Game in 2018

and lost 7-6 to Mississippi College. NCAA DII SOUTH REGION RANKINGS: Valdosta State remained at No. 2, Montevallo dropped from No.

4 to No. 5, Delta State and Lee stayed at No. 8 and No.

9, respectively, in this week's rankings. Tampa is No. 1. Saint Leo sits at No. 3 and Rollins is No. 4. Florida Southern is sixth and Nova Southeastern seventh. Lynn is No. 10.

- One more regional ranking will be announced prior to NCAA Division II Baseball Championship selection show on May 15.
- Eight teams will be selected for the South Regional which will be split into two, four-team regional sites.
