

## **GAME NOTES**

- The Flames are playing the final of four-consecutive eight rebounds, five assists and two steals. home games to complete its pre-Christmas schedule.
- Lee opens the spring semester on Jan. 2 at AUM. Following another road contest at Shorter (Jan., 6). the Flames return to Walker Arena on Jan. 8 to face West Alabama.
- The Flames have won three of their last four games, including Monday's 87-64 takedown of Valdosta State. Lee jumped out to a 43-21 halftime lead and cruised through the final 20 minutes for the win.
- Jalen Page drilled 5-of-6 3-pointers on his way to a game-high 19 points. PJay Smith added 12 points,

- Quay Kennedy will be recognized as Lee's latest 1,000-point scorer prior to today's game. He went over the 1,000 point mark at Christian Brothers on December 4. He currently has 1,030 career points.
- PJay Smith was named GSC Freshman of the Week on Tuesday for last week's performance.
- As of Dec. 15, UAH has made the most three-point field goals (139) in Div. II while taking the secondmost three's (362). The Chargers also ranked seventh among national leaders with 11.6 three's made per game as well as first with 218 total assists.
