

GAME NOTES

- on the schedule in January.
- After today's game, Lee hosts Montevallo next Saturday (Jan. 15) before hitting the road for the rest of the month with trips to Mississippi College (Jan. 20), Delta State (Jan. 22) and West Alabama (Jan. 29).
- The Flames have won three of their last four games, including Thursday's 83-65 takedown of Shorter in Rome. Lee had won two straight against Valdosta State and UAH before AUM ended the streak with a 68-61 loss last Sunday in Montgomery.
- UWA has won six straight with four of those

- The Flames are playing the first of two home games against GSC competition. The last three came at home against Shorter (80-65), West Florida (74-68) and Valdosta State (84-74).
 - UWA is just 2-2 in games played on the road, while the Flames are 4-1 in home games.
 - · Lee averages 75.6 ppg (No. 6 GSC), while UWA is eighth (72.5 ppg). The Tigers lead the GSC by allowing just 57.7 ppg and a scoring margin of 14.8 ppg. Lee is fifth in the GSC at 70.4 ppg allowed and fourth with a margin of +5.2.
 - Lee is second in GSC with .473 shooting percentage. UWA has made .444 of its shots (No. 10).
