GAME NOTES

- · Lee has won six of its last seven contests. West Georgia has posted seven wins in its last eight.
- The Flames are coming off a 74-60 win against AUM on Saturday. Lee led 31-19 at the half. Michael McGuirk paced Lee with 20 points to go with five rebounds and two blocked shots. Quay Kennedy added 14 points, six boards and two blocked shots.
- The Wolves had their six-game win streak ended at Union (50-74) on Feb. 2. They rebounded to hand Christian Brothers an 83-77 loss this past Saturday.
- Six of the 17 games in the series were decided by 3 point or less. Three of those were decided by one

point and three by three points. Two of the last three games had one point differentials.

- ROAD TO THE PLAYOFFS -- With three weeks remaining in the regular season, the Flames find themselves in third with West Georgia close behind in fifth in the GSC. The top eight teams earn berths to the GSC Championship.
- Following tonight's game, Lee has four-consecutive road games (at UAH, at Valdosta State, at West Florida and a makeup game at Mississippi College) before returning to Walker Arena for the final two regular season games againt Christian Brothers and Union.
