GAME NOTES

- The Flames begin GSC conference play tonight against the team that ended their shortened 2021 spring season last year. Union claimed the 2021 Spring Championships Series title in April, which the first conference title of any kind in the history of Union men's soccer.
- •Today's game, and the women's soccer game directly after, are "more than just games." Both games against Union are the annual Kickin' It for Kids with Cancer games, sponsored by the Austin Hatcher Foundation.
- The Flames are coming off a dominating win against Tusculum University, 4-0. The Flames scored all four goals in the second half. Due to red cards, Lee played a man up for the majority of the game, and played two men up after Tusculum's second red card in the 76th minute. Mattia Balzano scored the first and third goal. McWhorter and Arantes tallied the other two goals.
- The Union University men's soccer team climbed

two spots in this week's United Soccer Coaches National Rankings to No. 8. The No. 8 national ranking is the highest in Union men's soccer history.

- Union's goalkeeper Botond Nemeth was named GSC Men's Soccer Defender of the Week for the week ending September 12. Nemeth helped the Bulldogs record their third shutout of the season against LMU this past week.
- Union is coming off of a 0-0 double-overtime tie against Lincoln Memorial. The Bulldogs outshot the railsplitters 23-10, with nine shots on goal.
- · Coach Potteiger's thoughts- "We know our league is going to be a tough and that each match will present a different challenge for us. But we are excited to get into the GSC schedule and we feel like we have an opportunity to have a special season."
- · After tonight, the Flames will continue conference play with a game on Sunday, Sept. 19, against Christian Brothers University at 3 p.m.
