GAME NOTES

- OVERVIEW: Lee and Carson-Newman are facing off for the 27th time with the previous meetings evenly split. The Eagles and Flames split the two games played last season with both teams winning on the road. Lee won 11-9 on February 8 with C-N winning 12-7 on March 15.
- **► LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames opened GSC play at UAH and won the final two games 4-2 and 14-6 after dropping the opener 14-0. In Sunday's finale, Lee made the most out of four hits with Dylan Standifer and Cam Suto each drilling two-run home runs and Riley Black stroking a double. Jack Nedrow gave up just one run on four hits, walked one and struck out seven in six innings to earn the win. Hunter Lane was credited with his second save of the season.
- TODAY'S OPPONENT: Carson-Newman ended a three-game losing streak with a three-game sweep of Emory & Henry this past weekend. The Eagles won 15-4 and 5-0 in Saturday's doubleheader before scoring the final four runs to win 8-6 on Sunday. The Eagles are 0-6 in games played on the road this season.
- **DUPCOMING:** The Flames return to conference action with a three-game series this weekend against West Georgia. Lee is scheduled for a single game on Friday at 3 p.m. with a doubleheader on Saturday beginning at 1 p.m.


