## GAME NOTES

➔ **OVERVIEW:** Lee and LMU are meeting for the 15<sup>th</sup> time with LMU holding a two-game lead. The teams split last year's games with each team winning their home game. The Flames won 7-4 on February 22 and LMU posted a 9-5 win on March 8.

➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames opened the season with a 16-5 win over Hillsdale College before the Chargers claimed the last two games 3-1 and 8-7. Noah Hattier was 5-for-5 with a double and five runs scored in game 1. Brandon Daniels was 6-for-9 for the weekend with a double, three RBI and three runs scored. Sam Fulton picked up the win in the opener after not allowing a hit and striking out nine in five innings pitched.

➔ **TODAY'S OPPONENT:** LMU (Harrogate, Tenn.) swept a three-game series against Cedarville (Ohio). The Railsplitters won the opener 25-5 on Friday and won both ends of Saturday's doubleheader 9-5 and 5-1. Carson Boles ripped seven hits in 11 at bats to lead LMU. Collin Goda also collected seven hits. They both tripled, drove in five runs and scored six times. Eli Edds and Christian Pencek each pitched five innings and picked up wins on the mound.

➔ **UPCOMING:** The Flames remain at home for a three-game series against Mars Hill University this Saturday and Sunday. Lee completes a eight-game home stand to begin the season with a single, nine-inning game against Young Harris College on February 14.
