

GAME NOTES

- Trickly For A Cure: Friday night is #FiredUp For A Cure Night with proceeds from specialty concession items and t-shirt sales to be donated to the American Cancer Society, Luminaria will be on display to honor loved ones of our players and staff affected by cancer.
- OVERVIEW: The Flames and Hawks have faced-off 65 times prior to this weekend with Lee holding a 48-17 advantage (21-8 at home). Lee has won five of the last six contests, including a 19-8 win in last year's GSC Championship Game.
- ◆ LAST TIME OUT: The Flames return home after playing the last five games on the road. During that time, Lee posted a 2-3 record with a 2-1 mark at Christian Brothers and a pair of non-conference losses at Trevecca Nazarene and a 6-4 loss at Young Harris on Tuesday.
- TODAY'S OPPONENT: Shorter has won three of its last four. The Hawks won two of three at Mars Hill last weekend and beat Clark Atlanta 19-8 Tuesday afternoon, Justin Barnes was 3-for-3 with four RBI in the win over Clark Atlanta. The Hawks are 12-11 on the road this season.
- **POSTSEASON NEARING:** The Flames enter the final weekend in seventh place in the GSC. Shorter is just a half-game ahead in sixth. Delta State (12-14), West Alabama (12-15) and AUM (10-17) are still in the fight for a Championship berth. While Shorter is at Lee, UWA travels to Union, AUM is at UAH and Delta State is at Mississippi College. Lee can clinch a GSC berth with two wins, or two UWA losses or a Lee win combined with a UWA loss.
- SC CHAMPIONSHIP: The top eight teams will compete in the GSC Championship May 5-9 at Choccolocco Park in Oxford. Alabama.
