### **GAME NOTES**

- OVERVIEW: Lee and Union are meeting for the 46th time and 19th since the 2013-2014 season. UU has won three of the last four after the Flames had won the previous four.
- **♦ LAST TIME OUT:** Lee trailed by as many as 17 points before storming back in the second half to win at West Georgia 76-71. Play Smith led Lee with 22 points with Beyuan Hendricks close behind at 19. Noah Boler tallied a double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds.
- REGION RANKINGS: Nova Southeastern (23-0) holds the top spot in the South Region. UAH (20-6) is second with Lee third. West Alabama (16-6) is fourth, while Florida Southern (17-7), Tuskegee (19-7), Embry-Riddle (15-8) and West Georgia (15-8) round out the top eight.
- TIGHT CONFERENCE STANDINGS: Entering the final weekend, the top four teams are all within 1.5 games. West Alabama and UAH are tied for first at 17-5 and are the only two teams to clinch a Quarterfinal home game. Lee is one game back with West Georgia one-half game behind in fourth. A Lee win or a Valdosta State loss will secure a Quarterfinal home game for the Flames.
- ➡ MILESTONE WATCH: Jayce Willingham went over 1,000 points in his Lee career at Montevallo. Michael McGuirk scored his 1,000th point at AUM, while Beyuan Hendricks went over 1,000 career points last Saturday at West Georgia.
- **DIPCOMING:** The Flames complete the regular season against Christian Brothers on Saturday at 2 p.m. and will play in a GSC Quarterfinal game on Tuesday, February 28.




