- SC CHAMPIONSHIP HISTORY: The Lady Flames are making their eighth appearance in the GSC Championship and have posted a record of 13-6. Lee has advanced to the semfinal round eight times, the final four times and have won one championship. Union has posted a record of 20-3 in nine appearances. This will be their seventh final and are seeking their sixth title.
- LEE VS UU IN GSC CHAMPIONSHIP: This is the third straight year that Lee and Union will battle in the GSC Championship Final. The Lady Flames lost the previous two meetings in the final; 70-56 in 2021 and 58-44 in 2022. Overall, Lee is 1-4 against the Lady Bulldogs in the GSC Championship with semifinal losses in 2016 (69-50) and 2018 (66-56). Lee defeated Union 72-58 in the 2017 quarterfinal.
- REGION RANKINGS: Tampa (27-1) stands at the top of the South Region rankings with Eckerd (23-4) at No. 2. Union (23-3) is third and the Lady Flames are fourth. Valdosta State, Tuskegee (23-2), Nova Southeastern (21-7) and Lynn (20-7) round out the top eight. West Florida (21-6) is ninth and Savannah State (16-7) sits at No. 10.
- MILESTONE ALERT: Haley Schubert has scored 2,224 points to become the fifth Lady Flame to reach 2,000 career points. She passed Brooke (McKinnon) Evans (2,216) for third in Saturday's win. Vikki Clemmons is second (2,271) and Hollie (German) Lowe is Lee's leading scorere at 2.300. Schubert also has 531 rebounds and 519 assists in her career.
