## **GAME NOTES**

- WEEKLY AWARDS: Luke Collier was named GSC Freshman of the Week on Tuesday after hitting .412 (7-for-17) with two home runs, a double, seven runs scored and six RBI to help Lee post a 3-1 record last week.
- SC STAT LEADERS: Brandon Daniels is No. 8 (.398) in BAvg., tied for first with 35 hits and leads the GSC with 38 RBI. Dylan Standifer(31) and Daniels (29) are first and second in runs scored. Jack Nedrow is tied for first with five pitching wins and first with 39 Ks.
- **UPCOMING:** The Flames remain at home for a non-conference meeting with North Georgia on Tuesday (March 19) followed by a GSC home series with CBU next weekend.

#### **ABOUT THE WARHAWKS**

- SCHEDULE: AUM has lost its last two contests (5-4 in 10 innings against Columbus State on Tuesday and 10-4 in the series finale last Saturday). The Warhawks have won two of three in each of their four GSC series this season (at VSU and Shorter; and home against Mississippi College and West Alabama).
- SC LEADERS: Tyrese Rooks leads the GSC with 95 at bats, while Kasey Clark is third (91). Rooks is No. 4 in runs scored (27) and Clark is sixth (25).

- SERIES STREAKS: Lee won the last game and have posted wins in eight of the last 11 meetings. The Flames won two of three last year in Montgomery, winning 19-7 and 5-3 with a 7-6 loss in between. The 2019 season was the last time AUM won two of three in a season series. Lee won the opener 7-6 and AUM claimed the next two 11-1 and 6-2.
