GAME NOTES

- LEE IN NCAA TOURNAMENT: The Flames are making the program's third appearance in the NCAA Tournament and now hold a 5-5 record. Lee's last appearance was in 2022 where the No. 7 seed Flames won twice against Saint Leo and lost twice to Rollins. In 2021, Lee claimed two wins against Alabama Huntsville and lost to Tampa and West Florida as the No. 2 seed.
- **EXAMPLE AGAINST THE SOUTH REGION FIELD:** The Flames are 3-1 against Delta State and AUM; 2-1 against West Florida. and O-1 against Tampa. All time against teams in South Region 1, Lee is 39-21 against AUM and 2-3 against Tampa.
- FLAMES DIG THE LONG BALL: Lee has recorded the most home runs among South Region teams this season with 95. Tampa is second with 65. The Flames are No. 5 in the nation.
- ◆ LATE SEASON OFFENSIVE STRUGGLES: Despite scoring 24 runs on Thursday, the Flames have been held to three runs or fewer in six of their last nine games, including Friday when they were held to one run. The Flames are now averaging 9.11 runs per game. Thursday's game was the 25th time Lee scored 10+ runs this season.
- TIME TO AVOID A PATTERN: The Flames are hoping to avoid a pattern in this year's postseason. The Flames hit double-figures in beating West Georgia 10-2 in the GSC first round, followed by a 10-0 loss to Valdosta State and a 5-3 loss to Delta State. So far in the South Region, Lee beat AUM 24-7 in the opener and lost 13-1 to Tampa.

- SERIES STREAKS: Lee has won three of the four games played this season. The Flames won the first two games of the weekend series before AUM won the finale. Lee claimed the South Region opener 24-7 on Thursday. The Flames have won eight of the 11 games played in the last three seasons. This is the second time all-time that Lee and AUM have met in the NCAA South Regional.
