- RECENT RESULTS: The Railsplitters opened the season with a three-game sweep of Cedarville University, LMU won 9-4 on Friday and followed with 14-4 and 5-1 wins on Saturday.
- ◆ LAST YEAR: LMU finished the 2023 season with a 31-18 record and advanced to the Championship Series of the South Atlantic Conference Tournament where they won the first game before losing the next two to No. 1 seed Newberry College.
