- ◆ RECENT SCHEDULE: The Flames had a seven-game win streak snapped with an 8-2 loss in the final game against AUM this weekend. Lee has won two of three in each of their four GSC weekends.
- ◆ **GSC STAT LEADERS:** Brandon Daniels is No. 8 (.398) in BAvg., tied for first with 35 hits and leads the GSC with 38 RBI. Dylan Standifer(31) and Daniels (29) are first and second in runs scored. Jack Nedrow is tied for first with five pitching wins and first with 39 Ks.
- **UPCOMING:** The Flames remain at home for a GSC home series with CBU this weekend, followed by four straight games on the road next week.

ABOUT THE NIGHTHAWKS

- ◆ **SCHEDULE:** North Georgia has won nine straight with their last loss coming on March 2 at home against Columbus State (5-4). During the win streak, UNG has outscored its opponents 102-27 with four run-rule wins.
- COMMON OPPONENTS: Lee and UNG have both played Mars Hill and West Georgia so far this season. UNG opened the season winning two of three against Mars Hill and UNG won at West Georgia 6-2 on March 13. The Flames won two of three against Mars Hill and at UWG.
