GAME NOTES

- **REGULAR SEASON SUCCESS:** Lee won the 2024 GSC Regular Season by three games to earn the program's second GSC Regular Season title and the No. 1 seed.
- **LEE IN GSC TOURNAMENT:** The Flames are making the program's sixth appearance in the GSC Tournament and enter with a 10-9 record. Lee reached the championship game twice (2018 and 2022) and claimed the 2022 GSC Tournament Championship.
- **TOURNAMENT OPENING GAMES:** Since the Flames went 0-2 in 2016, Lee has won its opening game in each of the following four appearances.
- **LEE CAREER RECORD ALERT:** Dylan Standifer is just two RBI shy of tying Kevin Young's career mark of 194. He already owns the Lee career records for at bats (858), times hit by pitch (48) and sac flies (16). Jack Nedrow is one win away from tying Brandon Cofer (2001-2004) for career wins at 27 and is one shutout from tying three others with a career mark of five shutouts.
- **REGION RANKINGS:** The first DII baseball regional rankings were released on April 24 with Lee as one of the 10 teams listed. Joining the Flames from the GSC were AUM, Delta State and Valdosta State. Lee is third in this week's NCBWA South Region Poll. AUM is No. 4 with DSU at No. 6 and Valdosta State is seventh. Tampa and Saint Leo continue to hold the top two positions.

- **SERIES STREAKS:** Lee won two of the three meetings earlier this season in Carrollton. The Flames won the first two games 10-8 and 6-1 before UWG claimed the seven-inning contest 2-1. The Wolves won two of three in Cleveland last season after Lee swept all three games at UWG in 2021. In their lone postseason meeting, UWG won 8-3 in the final game of pool play of the 2018 GSC Championship at Delta State. Lee had already clinched the pool.
