# **ABOUT THE HAWKS**

**DUPCOMING:** Lee returns home for its final three regular season home games

(Mississippi College, Delta State and West Georgia) next weekend.

THEY'RE ON FIRE: The Flames have won seven straight for its longest winning streak since they posted an eight-game win streak early in the 2022-2023 season.

SC LEADERS: Beywan Hendricks leads the GSC with 5.8 assists per game, while JJ Barnes is seventh with 4.0 apg. Hendricks is fourth with 2.7 three-pointers made per game. Barnes is fourth with 1.8 steals per game. Noah Boler-Kyle is tied for fourth with

- SCHEDULE: Shorter has lost its last 17 contests, including a 76-69 defeat at the hands of Montevallo on Thursday. Carter Selman made six 3-pointers to lead Shorter with 18 points. Landon Tillman had 16 points and seven assists. The Hawks' last win came back on November 25 against West Florida (78-73). At the time, Shorter held a 3-2 record.
- ◆ GSC LEADERS: Landon Tillman is sixth in the GSC with a FT% of .798 (75-94). He is also tied for 16th with 2.9 assists per game.


