GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames gave up seven runs in the bottom of the first inning and were unable to overcome the deficit in a 12-7 loss at No. 1/No. 3 North Greenville. Luke Collier and JJ Williams recorded two hits each. Collier had a double and triple, while Williams homered.
- ➔ **ROAD TRAVAILS:** The Flames are 0-4 this year in road contests. They were 12-10 on the road last season and are 34-39 since 2022. They have lost six straight road games (three this year at Delta State, at North Greenville on Tuesday and two at Tampa in the 2024 Regional).
- ➔ **TALE OF THE LONG BALL:** The Flames have blasted 14 home runs in their 15 games with JJ Williams leading the team lead with five. The Warhawks have 12 in 14 games with Kyle Hipp and Zach Dew tallying three each. AUM pitchers have allowed 21 round-trippers, while Lee's pitchers have had 11 balls leave the park.
- ➔ **HITTING STREAKS:** Tucker Platt owns a seven-game hitting streak, while Luke Collier has recorded a hit in six straight games and Ashton Simmons has a hit in the last five. Collier has also reached base the last 12 games with Platt reaching safely the last nine.
- ➔ **IN THE RANKINGS:** The Flames are No. 9 with 14 points in the NCBWA South Region Poll, just one point behind West Florida at No. 8.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames remain on the road for a mid-week trip to Lincoln Memorial next Tuesday. Lee returns home March 7-8 against Union.

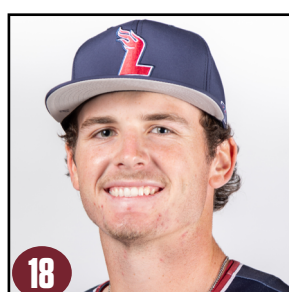
