GAME NOTES

- ➡ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames lost 7-0 at home to No. 21 Young Harris. Lee tallied five hits but were unable to push across any runs. JJ Williams and Brock Sisson posted two hits each in the loss.
- ➡ **ROAD TRAVAILS:** The Flames are 1-8 this year in road contests. They were 12-10 on the road last season and are 35-43 since 2022. They had lost 10 straight road games going back to the South Regional at Tampa before their 2-0 win at Carson-Newman on March 11.
- ➡ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 12-6 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 98-39 in games at home. Lee is 9-3 against CBU in games played in Memphis.
- ➡ **TALE OF THE LONG BALL:** The Flames have blasted 19 home runs in their 27 games with JJ Williams leading the team lead with five. The Bucs have 16 in 25 games with Jalen Smith leading the team with five and Cory Steinhauer close behind at three. CBU pitchers have allowed 22 round-trippers, while Lee's pitchers have had 17 balls leave the park. The Flames haven't homered in the last seven games. Their last was in the series opener with Union.
- ➡ **BATTING STREAKS:** JJ Williams has reached base safely in 19 straight games. Williams also has a hitting streak of seven games. Tucker Platt had a 19-game on base streak snapped in Tuesday's game against Young Harris.
- ➡ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames travel to Greeneville, Tenn., for a non-conference battle with Tusculum on Tuesday. Lee returns home for a GSC series with Montevallo next weekend.
