GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames won two-of-three GSC games against Union University. Lee won the opener 5-0 on Friday. Cooper Casteel recorded a complete game shutout with four strikeouts. Lee won the first game of Saturday's doubleheader 6-5 after trailing 5-2 going into the sixth inning. Union posted a two-run home run in the sixth inning of the finale to claim a 3-2 win.
- ➔ **ROAD TRAVAILS:** The Flames are 0-8 this year in road contests. They were 12-10 on the road last season and are 34-43 since 2022. They have lost 10 straight road games going back to the South Regional at Tampa.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 11-3 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 97-36 in games at home.
- ➔ **TALE OF THE LONG BALL:** The Flames have blasted 19 home runs in their 22 games with JJ Williams leading the team lead with five. The Eagles have 11 in 21 games with Tanner Kilgore leading the team with four. C-N pitchers have allowed 13 round-trippers, while Lee's pitchers have had 14 balls leave the park.
- ➔ **HITTING STREAKS:** Tucker Platt had his hitting streak of 11 snapped in the second game against Union. He has reached base safely in 15 consecutive games, while Luke Collier has a reached base streak of 19 and JJ Williams has reached base safely the last 14 contests.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames return home to take on Mississippi College this weekend.
