GAME NOTES

- ➔ **WEEKEND FORMAT:** Lee and Delta State are scheduled to play a doubleheader Friday with a single, nine-inning game on Saturday.
- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames swept visiting Hillsdale College last weekend. Lee held on to win the opener 14-10 after allowing six runs in the top of the ninth inning. Lee claimed Saturday's first game 11-0 before holding on for a 7-5 margin in the finale.
- ➔ **ROAD TRAVELS:** The Flames are on the road for the first time this season. Lee was just 12-10 in away contests last season and are 34-32 since 2022. DSU has won six straight at home and have claimed 10 consecutive GSC home wins. Their last lost at home was to Henderson State (12-5) on April 23, 2024. The last GSC opponent to beat them at home was West Florida (4-1) on March 23, 2024.
- ➔ **EARLY GSC START:** After just two non-conference weekends, the GSC season begins this weekend. This is the first of 11 GSC weekends amounting up to 33 regular season games.
- ➔ **PRESEASON PREDICTIONS:** Only four points separated Lee and DSU in the GSC Coaches Preseason Poll. Lee received two first-place votes and finished with 107 points, while DSU collected 103 points with three first-place votes.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames return home on February 18 to take on Carson-Newman followed by a weekend GSC series against UAH.
