#### GAME NOTES

- ◆ LAST TIME OUT: The Flames were swept in a three-game GSC series at AUM. The Flames lost their first two one-run games (6-5 and 11-10) of the season before falling 7-4 in the finale.
- PROAD TRAVAILS: The Flames are 0-7 this year in road contests. They were 12-10 on the road last season and are 34-42 since 2022. They have lost nine straight road games going back to the South Regional at Tampa.
- **♦ HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 9-2 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 95-35 in games at home.
- TALE OF THE LONG BALL: The Flames have blasted 17 home runs in their 18 games with JJ Williams leading the team lead with five. The Railsplitters have 17 in 18 games with Kasten Harvey leading the team with eight, LMU pitchers have allowed 10 round-trippers, while Lee's pitchers have had 13 balls leave the park.
- Tucker Platt and Luke Collier both own nine-game hitting streaks. Collier has also reached base the last 15 games with Platt reaching safely the last 11. JJ Williams has also reached base in the last 10 games.
- DOKING AHEAD: The Flames return home this weekend for a three-game GSC series with Union University before traveling to Carson-Newman on March 11.
