## GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames swept a three-game GSC series against UAH to even their conference record at 3-3. Lee posted a 15-5 run-rule shortened win on Friday, followed by two wins (5-0 and 13-3) in Saturday's doubleheader.
- ➔ **ROAD TRAVAILS:** The Flames are on the road for just the second time this season. Lee is 0-3 this year, was 12-10 on the road last season and are 34-38 since 2022. They have lost five straight road games (three this year at Delta State and two at Tampa in the 2024 Regional).
- ➔ **TALE OF THE LONG BALL:** The Flames have blasted 13 home runs in their 14 games with JJ Williams leading the team lead with four. The Trailblazers have 17 in 15 games with Gideon Antle, Josh Foulks and Landson Shaw tallying three each. NGU pitchers have allowed six round-trippers, while Lee's pitchers have had 11 balls leave the park.
- ➔ **HITTING STREAKS:** Tucker Platt owns a six-game hitting streak, while Luke Collier has recorded a hit in five straight games. Collier has also reached base the last 11 games with Platt reaching safely the last eight.
- ➔ **IN THE RANKINGS:** After dropping out of the NCBWA South Region Poll last week, the Flames have re-entered the poll at No. 9 with 14 points, just one point behind West Florida at No. 8.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames remain on the road this weekend to take on AUM before traveling to Lincoln Memorial next Tuesday. Lee returns home March 7-8 against Union.
