GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames swept at three-game GSC series at Christian Brothers over the weekend. Lee took down CBU 10-2 in the opener before sweeping Saturday's doubleheader 13-4 and 6-2.
- ➔ **ROAD TRAVAILS:** The Flames are 4-8 this year in road contests. They were 12-10 on the road last season and are 38-43 since 2022. They had lost 10 straight road games going back to the South Regional at Tampa before their current four-game road win streak. Lee is 3-6 in games played in Greenville, including a 6-4 loss last season.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 12-6 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 98-39 in games at home.
- ➔ **TALE OF THE LONG BALL:** The Flames have blasted 21 home runs in their 30 games with JJ Williams leading the team lead with five. The Pioneers have 13 in 29 games with Max Schmarder, Omar Carreras and Ty Smith sharing the team lead of three. TU pitchers have allowed 22 round-trippers, while Lee's pitchers have had 21 balls leave the park. The Flames ended a seven-game home run drought on Friday with Ryan Valdes' first of two home runs during the weekend.
- ➔ **BATTING STREAKS:** JJ Williams has reached base safely in 22 straight games. Williams also has a hitting streak of 10 games.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames return home for a three-game GSC series with Montevallo this weekend to begin a seven-game home stand.
