GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LOOKING TO GET HOT AGAIN:** The Flames had won seven straight games before dropping the series opener with West Florida on April 4. Since then, Lee has gone 3-4 and have lost their last three. The Flames had won seven straight GSC games and 10 of 11 before losing the last two at VSU last weekend.
- ➔ **ROAD TRAVAILS:** The Flames are 6-10 this year in road contests. They were 12-10 on the road last season and are 40-45 since 2022. They had lost 10 straight road games going back to the South Regional at Tampa before winning six straight through the first game at Valdosta State. The Flames have lost their last two road games. Lee is 6-8 in games played at UWA and have lost the last two.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 17-9 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 103-42 in games at home.
- ➔ **POSTSEASON PICTURE:** With two weekends remaining, the Flames are currently in fifth place in the GSC standings. The top eight teams earn a berth in the GSC Championships. Lee is two games behind Mississippi College (17-10) and three behind West Florida (18-9). Delta State has already clinched a berth to the 2025 GSC Championship. Montevallo (14-13) is one game behind Lee. Union (12-14) is 2.5 games behind the Flames, while West Alabama and Trevecca (12-15) are three games behind Lee.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames complete the regular season at home against Trevecca next weekend.
- ➔ **MILITARY APPRECIATION DAY:** This year's event is scheduled for April 26 between 12 and 2 p.m. with a pre-game ceremony at 12:15 followed by a doubleheader with Trevecca at 1.


