## GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames lost all three GSC contests at Delta State. Lee was shutout in both games of Friday's doubleheader (6-0 and 3-0). The Flames outhit DSU 11-9 on Saturday but left 12 runners on base in a 8-5 loss.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 5-2 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 91-35 in games at home.
- ➔ **TALE OF THE LONG BALL:** The Flames have blasted nine home runs in their 10 games with JJ Williams and Cooper Doughman tied for the team lead with two each. The Eagles have five in 10 games with Tanner Kilgore producing three of those. C-N pitchers have allowed five round-trippers, while Lee's pitchers have had 10 balls leave the park.
- ➔ **ABOUT THE EAGLES:** C-N's 10-0 start is its best in modern history. Their previous best was a 7-0 start in 2020. They have three wins against King and Emory & Henry, two against Charleston (W.Va.) and one each against Shorter and Trevecca. Nine of their 10 games were played at home with the lone road contest at Shorter.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames remain at home this weekend for a three-game GSC series with UAH. Barring changes due to weather, the series is set for a single game on Friday with a doubleheader planned for Saturday.
