GAME NOTES

- ➔ **WEEKEND FORMAT:** Barring any more changes due to weather, the Flames and Lions are scheduled to play two nine-inning games on Saturday starting at noon and one nine-inning game on Sunday at 2 pm.
- ➔ **SEASON OPENERS:** The Flames have won 24 straight season openers, including 2014 and 2015 when they faced Emmanuel. Lee lost the first three games of the 2000 season.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 86-33 in games at home.
- ➔ **GSC PRESEASON:** The Flames were selected to finish second in the GSC after receiving 107 points and two first-place votes from the league's head coaches via an online poll. Tim Godden and Cooper Doughman (transfer from AUM) earned spots on the Preseason All-GSC Team.
- ➔ **LEE IN THE PRESEASON RANKINGS:** Lee collected 25 points and sit just outside of the Top 25 of the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) Division II Poll. The Flames are fourth behind Tampa, West Florida and Nova Southeastern in the NCBWA South Region Preseason Poll. In the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Preseason Poll, the Flames landed at No. 22 with 85 points.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames host Lincoln Memorial in a single nine-inning game on Feb. 5. Next weekend, Lee is set for a three-game series with Hillsdale College (Hillsdale, Mich.).
