

GAME NOTES

- WEEKEND FORMAT: Lee and Hillsdale are scheduled to play a single nine-inning game on Friday at 4 pm and continue the series with a doubleheader beginning at 1 pm on Saturday.
- ◆ LAST TIME OUT: The Flames evened their record at 2-2 with a 5-1 defeat of Lincoln Memorial on Wednesday. JJ Williams and Isaiah French led the Lee offense with two hits. French gathered a team-high two RBI. The Lee pitching scattered four hits and struck out eight.
- **♦ HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 2-2 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 88-35 in games at home.
- ◆ **ABOUT HILLSDALE:** Hillsdale is located in Hillsdale, Mich., and is a member of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC). They lost 16 players off last year's roster, including three of the team's four weekend starters and five everyday players in the field. Hillsdale posted a record of 21-28 overall and were 15-17 in the G-MAC in 2024.
- PRESEASON PREDICTIONS: While Lee was picked to finish second by the GSC coaches, Hillsdale was picked to finish fifth out of six teams in the G-MAC North Division.
- DOOKING AHEAD: The Flames hit the road for the first time on Wednesday at Young Harris before opening GSC play at Delta State next weekend. Lee returns home on February 18 to take on Carson-Newman followed by a weekend GSC series against UAH.
