# **GAME NOTES**

- WEATHER DISRUPTIONS: After last weekend's schedule was amended due to weather, the weather has forced changes again this week. Today's game was moved up to noon from 3 pm. Sunday's game has been flipped to Friday in an attempt to avoid forecasted rain.
- **◆ LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames had their streak of 24 straight wins in season openers snapped with a 19-7 loss to Emmanuel in Saturday's first game. The Flames won the second game 9-3, but the Lions claimed the weekend series with a 15-4 win on Sunday.
- **♦ HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 87-35 in games at home.
- **➡ ABOUT THE RAILSPLITTERS:** LMU split a four-game series this past weekend at North Georgia with UNG winning 9-1 on Friday and the teams trading wins in Saturday's doubleheader. LMU came from seven runs behind to beat UNG 9-8 on Sunday.
- PRESEASON PREDICTIONS: While Lee was picked to finish second by the GSC coaches, LMU was selected third in the SAC Preseason Coaches Poll. Chris Hall (OF), Katen Harvey (3B) and Christian Pencek (SP) were All-SAC First Team. Tim Gooden (RP) and Cooper Doughman (C) earned spots on the Preseason All-GSC Team.
- DOKING AHEAD: The Flames host Hillsdale College (Hillsdale, Mich.) this weekend with a single game on Friday at 4 pm followed by a doubleheader on Saturday at 1 pm.
