## GAME NOTES

- ➔ **WEEKEND BREAKDOWN:** With rain in the forecast, the weekend schedule has been changed to a doubleheader on Friday and a single nine-inning game on Saturday. If unable to complete the three games by Saturday, the teams have agreed to exercise the Sunday play option if the series cannot conclude on Saturday.
- ➔ **ROAD TRAVAILS:** The Flames are 1-8 this year in road contests. They were 12-10 on the road last season and are 35-43 since 2022. They had lost 10 straight road games going back to the South Regional at Tampa before Tuesday's 2-0 win at Carson-Newman.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 11-3 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 97-36 in games at home.
- ➔ **TALE OF THE LONG BALL:** The Flames have blasted 19 home runs in their 23 games with JJ Williams leading the team lead with five. The Choctaws have 26 in 23 games with Korey Cooper and Bryce LaRocca leading the team with six. MC pitchers have allowed 25 round-trippers, while Lee's pitchers have had 14 balls leave the park.
- ➔ **BATTING STREAKS:** Luke Collier has reached base safely in the last 20 games. Tucker Platt has done the same in 16 games, while JJ Williams has reached base safely the last 15 contests and Isaiah French has a streak of 10 games reached safely.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames remain at home against RV/#20 Young Harris on Tuesday at 4 p.m.
