GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames won one of three at Valdosta State over the weekend. Lee outslugged VSU 14-8 on Friday before dropping both games of Saturday's doubleheader. Lee mustered just three hits in the 5-1 loss in the opener and VSU won the finale 8-7 on an error in the bottom of the seventh.
- ➔ **ROAD TRAVAILS:** The Flames are 6-10 this year in road contests. They were 12-10 on the road last season and are 40-45 since 2022. They had lost 10 straight road games going back to the South Regional at Tampa before their current five-game road win streak.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 17-8 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 103-41 in games at home.
- ➔ **POSTSEASON PICTURE:** With two weekends remaining, the Flames are currently in fifth place in the GSC standings. The top eight teams earn a berth in the GSC Championships. Lee is two games behind Mississippi College (17-10) and three behind West Florida (18-9). Delta State has already clinched a berth to the 2025 GSC Championship. Montevallo (14-13) is one game behind Lee. Union (12-14) is 2.5 games behind the Flames, while West Alabama and Trevecca (12-15) are three games behind Lee.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames travel to Livingston, Alabama, to take on West Alabama this weekend before hosting Trevecca next weekend in their final regular season games.
- ➔ **MILITARY APPRECIATION DAY:** This year's event is scheduled for April 26 between 12 and 2 p.m. with a pre-game ceremony at 12:15 followed by a doubleheader with Trevecca at 1.


