## GAME NOTES

- ➔ **MILITARY APPRECIATION DAY:** The event is to honor current and veteran military members of all branches for their dedicated service to our country. Activities will last from noon to about 2 p.m. with a special program at 12:15. Be sure to bid on items in the silent auction as 100% of the proceeds from this event will be donated to veteran needs right here in the Bradley County community.
- ➔ **LOOKING TO GET HOT AGAIN:** The Flames had won seven straight games before dropping the series opener with West Florida on April 4. Since then, Lee has gone 3-7 and have lost their last six. The Flames had won seven straight GSC games and 10 of 11 before losing the last five.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 17-9 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 103-42 in games at home. Lee is 26-6 against Trevecca in games played at home.
- ➔ **POSTSEASON PICTURE:** With this the final weekend, the Flames are currently tied for fifth place in the GSC standings with Montevallo, West Alabama and Trevecca. Union (14-15) makes it five teams fighting for the final four spots. Delta State (23-7), Valdosta State (21-8), West Florida (20-10) and Mississippi College (18-12) are already in.
- ➔ **OTHER GSC SERIES:** While Lee and Trevecca battle here, UWA is at UAH and UWF travels to VSU. Montevallo is at AUM, Delta State plays at Mississippi College and Union hosts Christian Brothers.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The top eight teams in the GSC standings will earn a trip to the 2025 GSC Championship May 2-6 in Oxford, Ala.

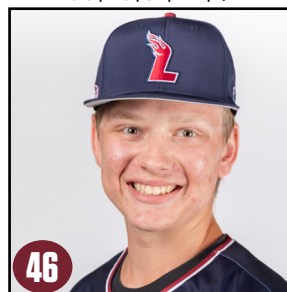
