GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LEE IN GSC TOURNAMENT:** The Flames are making the program's seventh appearance in the GSC Tournament and are now 11-12. Lee reached the championship game twice (2018 and 2022) and claimed the 2022 GSC Tournament Champions. The Flames are now 5-2 in opening games at the GSC Tournament. Lee is 2-5 when facing elimination in the GSC Tournament.
- ➔ **LEE VS TREVECCA IN GSC TOURNAMENT:** First meeting.
- ➔ **LOOKING TO GET HOT AGAIN:** The Flames ended a seven game losing streak with a 9-8 walk-off win against Trevecca last Saturday. Lee ended March with a seven-game win streak and had won eight of their last nine. The Flames were just 4-9 during the month of April and have lost 9 of their last 10.
- ➔ **ROAD TRAVAILS:** The Flames are 6-14 away from home this year. They were 12-10 on the road last season and are 40-49 since 2022. They had lost 10 straight road games going back to the South Regional at Tampa before winning six straight through the first game at Valdosta State. The Flames have lost their last six games away from home.
- ➔ **REGION RANKINGS:** In this week's NCAA DII South Region rankings, the Flames are not ranked in the top 10. Tampa is No. 1, West Florida is second and Florida Southern is third. Delta State is No. 4 with Rollins completing the top five. Mississippi College sits at No. 6, Lynn is seventh and Valdosta State is No. 8. Nova Southeastern and Spring Hill are ninth and 10th.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The winner of this game moves on to play again on Monday, while the season is over for the loser.

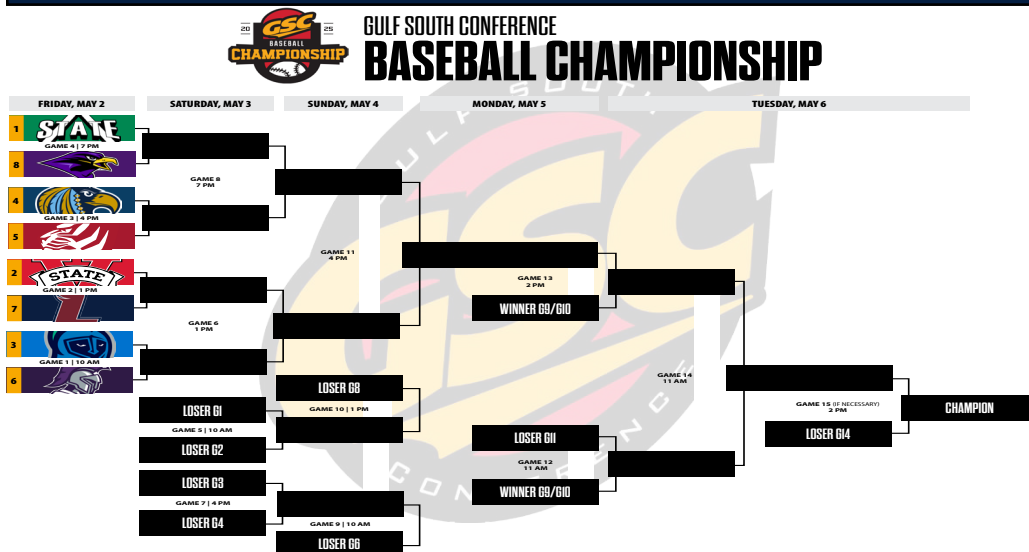
