## GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames had their seven-game win streak snapped with a 9-3 loss in the first game to West Florida. Lee swept Saturday's doubleheader to win the series with back-to-back walk-off wins. Brock Sisson delivered a two-run single in game one and Malachi Cloud scored on a wild pitch in game two.
- ➔ **ROAD TRAVAILS:** The Flames are 5-8 this year in road contests. They were 12-10 on the road last season and are 39-43 since 2022. They had lost 10 straight road games going back to the South Regional at Tampa before their current five-game road win streak.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 17-7 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 103-40 in games at home. Lee is 7-3 at home against Tusculum and have won the last five.
- ➔ **TALE OF THE LONG BALL:** The Flames have blasted 25 home runs in their 37 games with JJ Williams leading the team lead with seven. The Pioneers have 18 in 37 games with Max Schmardeer, Omar Carreras and Ty Smith sharing the team lead with three each. TU pitchers have allowed 35 round-trippers, while Lee's pitchers have had 26 balls leave the park.
- ➔ **BATTING STREAKS:** JJ Williams has reached base safely in 29 straight games. Williams also has a hitting streak of 17 games.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames travel to Valdosta State this weekend for a GSC series before returning home next Tuesday for a non-conference battle with North Greenville University.
