GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames remained unbeaten in mid-week games with a 10-0 run-rule shortened game against Carson-Newman. JJ Williams and Luke Collier stroked four hits each to lead Lee's 14-hit attack. Williams finished a home run shy of the cycle. Isaiah French joined Williams and Collier with two RBI a piece.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 6-2 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 92-35 in games at home. Lee is just 3-4-1 all-time at home against UAH.
- ➔ **TALE OF THE LONG BALL:** The Flames have blasted nine home runs in their 11 games with JJ Williams and Cooper Doughman tied for the team lead with two each. The Chargers have five in 11 games with nobody recording more than one. UAH pitchers have allowed six round-trippers, while Lee's pitchers have had 10 balls leave the park.
- ➔ **ABOUT THE CHARGERS:** UAH began the GSC schedule with two home wins against Christian Brothers. UAH won the opener 6-5 before CBU claimed the second game of the doubleheader 5-2. UAH claimed the series win with a 21-2 blasting of CBU on Saturday. The Chargers swept a four-game series with Missouri-St. Louis the prior weekend.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames travel to Tigerville, S.C., to take on No. 1/No. 4 North Greenville on Tuesday before battling AUM next weekend in Montgomery.

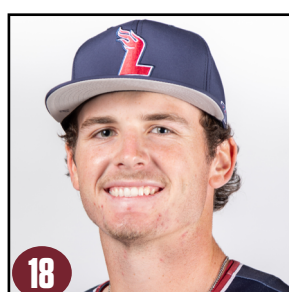
