GAME NOTES

- LAST TIME OUT: The Flames scored 16 runs on 19 hits to win 16-2 at Tusculum on Tuesday. JJ Williams was 5-for-5 with two home runs. He scored six runs and drove in four.
- **ROAD TRAVAILS:** The Flames are 5-8 this year in road contests. They were 12-10 on the road last season and are 39-43 since 2022. They had lost 10 straight road games going back to the South Regional at Tampa before their current five-game road win streak.
- HOME SWEET HOME: Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 12-6 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 98-39 in games at home. Lee is 8-5 at home against Montevallo with two wins in a row and six wins in the last seven played in Cleveland. The last loss was a 19-16 marathon on April 6, 2023.
- TALE OF THE LONG BALL: The Flames have blasted 23 home runs in their 31 games with JJ Williams leading the team lead with seven. The Falcons have 41 in 31 games with Connor Crowson leading the team with 10. UM pitchers have allowed 36 round-trippers, while Lee's pitchers have had 21 balls leave the park. The Flames have homered in three of the last four games while UM has hit a home run in four of their last five games.
- **➡ BATTING STREAKS:** JJ Williams has reached base safely in 23 straight games. Williams also has a hitting streak of 11 games.
- DOKING AHEAD: The Flames remain at home for a three-game GSC series with West Florida next weekend to continue a seven-game home stand.
