## GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames were held to three hits in a 4-0 loss at Lincoln Memorial on Tuesday. Isaiah French and Ashton Simmons singled and Tucker Platt doubled in the loss.
- ➔ **ROAD TRAVELS:** The Flames are 0-8 this year in road contests. They were 12-10 on the road last season and are 34-43 since 2022. They have lost 10 straight road games going back to the South Regional at Tampa.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 9-2 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 95-35 in games at home.
- ➔ **TALE OF THE LONG BALL:** The Flames have blasted 17 home runs in their 19 games with JJ Williams leading the team lead with five. The Bulldogs have three in 17 games with Carson Chavies leading the team with two. UU pitchers have allowed seven round-trippers, while Lee's pitchers have had 13 balls leave the park.
- ➔ **HITTING STREAKS:** Tucker Platt extended his hitting streak to 10 at LMU. He has also reached base safely in 12 consecutive games, while Luke Collier has a reached base streak of 16 and JJ Williams has reached base safely the last 11 contests.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames travel to Carson-Newman for a mid-week non-conference battle on Tuesday before returning home to take on Mississippi College next weekend.

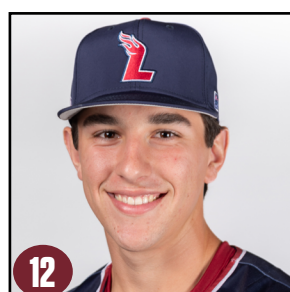

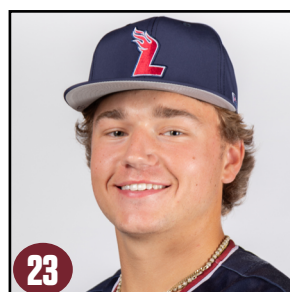

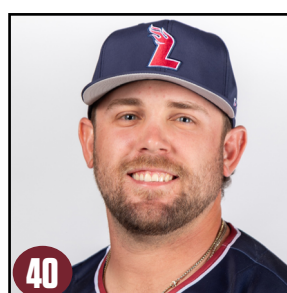
