GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames swept Montevallo to run their win streak to seven games. It was the team's fourth weekend series sweep of the season and second consecutive against GSC teams. Lee has recorded three series sweeps against GSC opposition this season.
- ➔ **ROAD TRAVAILS:** The Flames are 5-8 this year in road contests. They were 12-10 on the road last season and are 39-43 since 2022. They had lost 10 straight road games going back to the South Regional at Tampa before their current five-game road win streak.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 15-6 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 101-39 in games at home. Lee is just 4-6 at home against West Florida, but have won the last four.
- ➔ **TALE OF THE LONG BALL:** The Flames have blasted 25 home runs in their 34 games with JJ Williams leading the team lead with seven. The Argonauts have 13 in 33 games with Brett Rowell leading the team with five. UWF pitchers have allowed 15 round-trippers, while Lee's pitchers have had 24 balls leave the park. The Flames have homered in five of the last seven games while UWF has been homerless in their last seven games.
- ➔ **BATTING STREAKS:** JJ Williams has reached base safely in 26 straight games. Williams also has a hitting streak of 14 games. Josiah Miller has reached base in his last nine games.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames remain at home for a mid-week non-conference game against Tusculum on Tuesday at 6 p.m. before traveling to Valdosta State next weekend.




