## GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames salvaged the final game of the GSC weekend series against Mississippi College with a 1-0 win on Saturday. Malachi Cloud delivered an RBI single in the bottom of the seventh.
- ➔ **ROAD TRAVAILS:** The Flames are 1-8 this year in road contests. They were 12-10 on the road last season and are 35-43 since 2022. They had lost 10 straight road games going back to the South Regional at Tampa before Tuesday's 2-0 win at Carson-Newman.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee was 24-6 in games played in Larry Carpenter Stadium during the 2024 season and are 12-5 at home so far this season. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 98-38 in games at home. Lee is 5-6 at home against YHC with three straight losses. The last win at home against YHC was on March 11, 2020 (10-5).
- ➔ **TALE OF THE LONG BALL:** The Flames have blasted 19 home runs in their 26 games with JJ Williams leading the team lead with five. The Mountain Lions have 31 in 24 games with Kade Smallwood leading the team with eight and Jeremy Begora close behind at six. YHC pitchers have allowed 12 round-trippers, while Lee's pitchers have had 15 balls leave the park. The Flames haven't homered in the last six games. Their last was in the series opener with Union.
- ➔ **BATTING STREAKS:** Tucker Platt has reached base safely in 19 straight games, while JJ Williams has reached base safely the last 18 contests. Isaiah French has a streak of 13 games reached safely. Williams also has a hitting streak of six games.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames travel to Memphis to take on Christian Brothers this weekend.
