GAME

- FLAMES TRYING TO TURN THINGS AROUND: The Flames have won three straight and five of the last 10 after posting wins in four of the previous five contests. Lee had a seven-game losing streak that spanned through December and the first game in January. The Flames are at .500 for the first time since they were 8-8 following a win against AUM on Jan. 23.
- Sec Postseason History: The Flames are making their eighth appearance in the GSC Championship with a record of 5-7. Lee has advanced to the semifinal round the last five years, but have yet to make a final. The Flames are 0-3 against UAH in the GSC Championships with tonight's meeting the first not in the semifinal round.
- **EXECUTE:** The Flames are averaging 70.0 points per game and are allowing 68.8 points for a scoring margin of +1.2. Lee has also recorded a rebound margin of +0.8 (No. 6 in GSC).
- SEC STATS STANDINGS: The Flames allow the fewest points (68.8 ppg) in the GSC, while UAH allows the third-fewest (72.6 ppg). Lee is fifth with a Team FG% at .457. UAH is first (.523). Lee is 10th with 33.3 rebounds per game and UAH is second at 38.8 rpg. UAH holds a +6.0 rebound margin (No. 2). UAH's Tommy Murr is fourth in scoring (20.9 ppg). Daniel Saylor is second (9.5 rpg) in rebounding and first with a FG% of .739. Blake Campbell (.582) and Murr (.534) are third and fourth, respectivley, in FG%.
