GAME NOTES

- ➔ **WHICH STREAK WILL END?:** The Choctaws enter tonight's game after losing their last four and six of the last seven contests. The Flames are 0-7 in GSC play for the first time in program history. The seven consecutive losses are the most since the Flames lost nine straight during the 2016-17 season. While Lee has lost three straight at home, the Choctaws have lost three consecutive games on the road.
- ➔ **LEE STATS:** The Flames are averaging 73.2 points per game and are allowing 71.5 points for a scoring margin of +1.7. Lee has also recorded a rebound margin of +2.0.
- ➔ **GSC STATS STANDINGS:** The Flames allow the second-fewest points (71.5 ppg) in the GSC. Lee is also second in Team FG% at .494. Only UAH boasts a higher FG% at .525. MC is last in the GSC with a FG% of .415. Lee (31.4) and MC (30.4) are 10th and 11th, respectively in rebounds per game. Noah Boler-Kyle is tied for fifth with two others with 1.1 blocked shots per game. He is tied for seventh with 12 total blocks and 19th with 5.2 rebounds per game. MC's Tyree Bracey is fifth in the GSC with 15 total blocks (1.1 bpg), while Judah Land has 12 blocked shots (0.9 bpg).
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Lady Flames continue their home stand on Saturday against Delta State. Lee heads West next weekend to take on Union and Christian Brothers before returning to home to host AUM (Jan. 23) and Montevallo (Jan. 25).




