- TLAMES TURNING THINGS AROUND: The Flames have won five of the last eight since suffering a seven-game losing streak that spanned through December and the first game in January, Lee won two in a row twice during that stretch.
- AGAINST THE TIGERS: The Flames outscored UWA by seven in the second half to win 69-65. Tariq Daughton led Lee with 16 points and two blocked shots, while Zach Gray tossed in 12 points and three rebounds. Willie Walton added 10 points to go with five rebounds. Noah Boler-Kyle had five rebounds and five assists to go along with six points.
- GAINING POSITION: The Flames are currently in ninth in the GSC. They are one-half game behind AUM (6-9) and UWA (6-9) for the final playoff spot.
- **♦ LEE STATS:** The Flames are averaging 71.1 points per game and are allowing 68.8 points for a scoring margin of +2.2. Lee has also recorded a rebound margin of +0.5 (No. 7 in GSC).
- SEC STATS STANDINGS: The Flames allow the fewest points (68.8 ppg) in the GSC, while VSU allows the most (81.8 ppg), Lee is also third in Team FG% at .468, behind UAH (.516) and Trevecca (.476). Lee is 10th with 32.6 rebounds per game and VSU is fifth at 36.3 rpg. VSU holds a -3.0 rebound margin (No. 9).
- LOOKING AHEAD: The Flames remain at home to take on West Florida on Saturday.
